2020 CTSFW Musician Workshops: Rescheduled, Modified, and Discounted!

The 2020 CTSFW Musician Workshops are rescheduled, modified, and discounted!

Rescheduled: One week only, July 27–31.

Modified: All ability levels will be taught during this week. Some sessions will be divided between students of similar ability levels.

Discounted: The registration fee is discounted to zero dollars. On-campus meal plan and housing applies.

Long-range travel financial assistance available for participants traveling 500 or more miles.

If circumstances result in cancelling this workshop, all participants will receive complete refunds.

How are the workshops organized?

Each workshop begins with registration on Sunday evening (late registration takes place on Monday morning). The first session begins Monday at 8:15 a.m. and the last session concludes on Friday at noon. Instruction is customized to the ability level of each student. Daily classes in playing technique and theology are part of the curriculum, as well as practice time. Lodging is available in our campus guest dorms. Dorm housing has limited availability, so early registration is strongly recommended. Meals are in Katherine Luther Dining Hall. Participants are encouraged to attend daily chapel services in Kramer Chapel, located on campus.

What topics are covered?

Students receive customized instruction based on ability level in the following:

- Registration
- Keyboard and pedal technique
- Leading congregational singing at the organ and/or piano through effective playing
- Hymn introductions
- Ideas for playing various settings of the Divine Service and daily prayer services (Matins, Vespers, etc.)
- Repertoire ideas
- Leading challenging hymns

What's my ability level?

At a minimum, participants should have proficient keyboard skills. They should be able to read and play both treble and bass clefs simultaneously, such as when playing a hymn. The following questions will help organists determine what level is most appropriate.

When I open the hymnal to an unfamiliar hymn:

- I have to practice it slowly before I am comfortable with it. (BASIC)
- I can do an adequate job the first time through. (INTERMEDIATE)
- I can sight read it easily. (ADVANCED)

When I look at a hymn with more complex rhythms:

- I am not confident how to count the beats. (BASIC)
- I understand the rhythm but still have trouble playing it correctly consistently. (INTERMEDIATE)
- It's usually not a problem. (ADVANCED)

My experience as an organist is described as:

- I have little experience and struggle regularly to provide confident leadership. (BASIC)
- I have little or some experience but am fairly confident in my playing, although I still find myself feeling uncomfortable. (INTERMEDIATE)
- I have a good deal of experience and/or confidence. (ADVANCED)

My use of the pedals is described as:

- I play the manuals (keyboards) only or play the pedals rarely. (BASIC)
- If I play the pedals, I often use the left foot only. (BASIC)
- I'm familiar with using both left and right feet in pedal playing. (INTERMEDIATE, ADVANCED)
