

100% Tuition Coverage Opt-In for Residential Church Worker Students

Concordia Theological Seminary, Fort Wayne (CTSFW), is offering 100% tuition coverage for church worker students who are enrolled in a residential program of study (MDiv, A.R., or MA in Deaconess Studies residential). In order to adequately fund full tuition, it is necessary that these students apply for their Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod (LCMS) District financial aid and any outside scholarships for which they may be eligible. The LCMS District financial aid and outside scholarship funds that students receive will be counted towards the 100% tuition coverage for the academic year. Other aid, such as home congregation support and Student Adoption gifts, will not be counted towards the 100% tuition coverage.

Eligible students are asked to sign this consent form to opt into the 100% tuition coverage program. Students who choose **not** to opt into this program will receive only the regular seminary tuition grant, as determined by the student's financial need (according to the student's FAFSA financial data—EFC).

CONSENT TO OPT INTO 100% TUITION COVERAGE:

- b) Attend all required financial literacy training events for CTSFW students; and
- c) Write thank you notes or letters to the donors who support the CTSFW financial aid program (student will be notified regarding donor contact).

I understand that the 100% tuition program does not cover any fees, books, supplies, health insurance, room, or board. I understand that if I refuse to follow through on this promise, I will be placed into the regular seminary tuition grant program where my seminary financial aid will be determined by my financial need (FAFSA) and will not fund my full tuition.
